The event will take place at the Tampa Convention Center, September 15-18. Already, more than 130 people have registered to volunteer, and we're looking forward to signing up another 600 volunteers so we can service 3,000 patients with wholistic health including free medical, dental and vision care along with many other services. Volunteers are comprised of medical and nonmedical volunteers, with the majority being nonmedical. In fact, for every physician who volunteers, we need four non-medical support staff. So regardless of your skill set, we NEED YOU!!

Professional, medical and general liability are covered free of charge. Category 1, Continuing Medical Education, and Continuing Education will also be provided free of charge. Following Jesus' example we will provide physical healing for disease, while providing vision to those with sight impairment, healing for those with illness and sadness, but always directing the masses to the Great healer for the worst disease of all—sin, and our need of true spiritual healing.

It reminds me of the first event I helped lead. It was in San Francisco, and God had provided us with half of the Armory building. The other half was actually being used as an adult film studio. After serving thousands of community patients on our side of the building, the managers and security officers came to me two days later with tears streaming down their faces. They said, "Thank you so much for coming here. This place is such a dark place, but your group brought light and happiness to this place. You showed us God's love." The same day, the assistant to the Mayor, after reluctantly supporting the event, said, "I may be a homosexual Jew, but I'm now the number one supporter of the Seventh-day Adventist Church (one of the event's partners), and if you ever need anything in the future, call me."

For 10 years, many of us have planned mobile mega clinics and hospitals, and the result has changed people's live. There are countless miraculous examples, and let me tell you about just one. It's about a man at that San Francisco event whom I'll call John. He had just moved to the city with his two toddlers. He was a single dad and unable to get a job. He had fallen and knocked out his two front teeth and had been told that he wasn't going to be able to get a job until he had teeth. Walking down the street pushing his stroller and crying out to God, he prayed, "Lord hear me help me provide for my little ones. Please, Lord, help me get my teeth fixed." Just then, the wind blew a piece of paper into the spokes of his stroller wheels, and he reached down and picked it up. It was an advertisement announcing our free dental, medical, and vision care at the Armory the next day. He and his 3-year-old and 10-month-old went straight there and camped out all night, walking in the next morning as the first patients. Dr. Beckermeyer, the event's head dentist, was able to fix John's front two teeth. John went straight from there to a job placement location and was offered a job. He then came back to the dental team at the Amory to say thank you.

Friends, how many more people are there like these in the Tampa Bay Area? We need you! Of course we need as many medical and healthcare volunteers as possible, but we are in big need of hundreds of non-medical volunteers to support this event.

Our world is <u>Upside Down!</u> We can't just preach words. We must preach God's love in action. This event in Tampa Bay will do both of these. So this is an appeal right now for all children, women, and men willing to show Christ's love to stand up and join the cause.
